



Ministry of Information and Communications Technology

eCorrespondence system

A successful proof of concept of eCorrespondence – enabling the electronic exchange of formal correspondence between government entities – was completed and a supplier was chosen to implement a system that will initially connect 4 entities with the Council of Ministers. Further rollout is planned to connect 49 entities by the end of 2016.

Ministry of Administrative Development

Mawared

Mawared, offering Human Resources Management functions for 39 entities added an additional 4 entities that are under implementation, and 10 more entities will not be using the full system, but will be integrated using an interface.

Supreme Education Council

eLearning Management System (LMS)

The LMS is an integrated learning environment which enables teachers to manage, develop and publish eContent and thus helps to improve communication and collaboration between all teachers, students, parents/guardians and school administrators.

The system is now implemented in 100% of independent schools in Qatar. The system records more than approximately10 million transactions each month during school terms.

Ministry of Economy and Commerce

Business Setup Services

First phase of the BSS project is completed. Internal launch of 42 digital services (with mobile apps) was completed within the Ministry. Full launch will be completed by October 2015.

Open Data Policy

Government entities shall:

- Assign responsibility to a senior officer of sufficient authority to oversee the administration and implementation of Open Data
- •Take immediate steps to develop their Agency Open Data plan and to publish it on their Open Data webpage
- Create an Open Data webpage and shall maintain and update it in a timely fashion
- Publish their data and information online in an open format that can be retrieved, downloaded, indexed and searched
- •Implement an online forum on their Open Data webpages to solicit feedback from the public (people and businesses) to encourage public discussions on Open Data
